

The following are two examples of the updates that my customers receive during the making process. The names of the customers are made invisible to protect their privacy.


Hi customer 1,

This week I cut the housings for the dovetails, finished the butternut backboards of the cabinet boxes and glued them together. They are strong enough to cary an eliphant. In the original design I was going to put plywood back panels in the boxes because they are dimensionally more stable. I suddenly realized that ifname, in her future house want the cabinet in the middle of the room she can do that because the cabinet will also look nice from the back. You could even use the boxes as separate units and pile them up where you need them and sleep on the shelfs ©. With this change the versatility of the cabinet increase considerably.

Next step are the black walnut frames. I am not looking forward to that part because it will be a slow process to do it right. So far, so good. Hope you guys like what you see so far. Have a great weekend,
